2. The Maine Society of Professional Engineers Board of Directors will award the Vernon T. Swain, P. E. / Robert E. Chute P. E. Scholarship after the MeSPE Scholarship Committee has reviewed the applications and presented their recommendations to the Board of Directors.
3. The courses you have taken and the credits earned for the 9th through 12th grades will be used to help evaluate your application.
4. Scholarships will be paid to the university or college financial aid office rather than the student. All scholarships are contingent upon your enrollment in an engineering program and being accepted by the university or college of your choice.
5. All applicants must intend to earn a degree in engineering and to enter the practice of engineering after graduation.

 - a. Scholarship winners will be notified by May 20, 2017.
